FROM THE MFI BOARD PRESIDENT



With the birth of every new project, company, program, and of course, offspring, we focus on one aspect throughout the beginning stages. That aspect is “growth”.

Many dictionaries define growth as ‘progressive development (evolution)’ or ‘an increase, expansion or development’. With the inception of the Mirasol Foundation, Inc. (MFI) in May of 2016, the Founding Committee, followed by the first Board Members, needed to focus on growth. We started through education and marketing. Educating the residents of the community about what the Foundation is and how it works is a continuing function of this Board. Marketing to community organizations, grant writers, and charities of Palm Beach County occurred successfully for us because Mirasol already had a presence in the County through three years of community service projects that preceded the Foundation.

MFI’s growth plan began in May of 2016 when the Mirasol Club & Association (MCA) Board decided to establish a charitable Foundation, similar to those of peer residential country clubs. The seeds were planted. The effort and time that the Mirasol administration, the Founding Committee, and the first Foundation Board Members dedicated strengthened the roots that were sprouting. Committees were established and their work firmed the stems of our greenery. As our plants were fertilized and watered through donations of money and time, their growth continued. Finally, at the end of our first season, April 2017, the Foundation awarded grants to twenty plus Palm Beach County Charities. At this point we watched as our plantings bloomed into beautiful sunflowers – each one representing a charity that we helped.

As you read through this review you will notice that we have included the growth cycle in our presentation of information. It is exciting that the beginning of each charity season (May) we plant the seeds all over again, until they bloom and grow into the next season’s flowers (the selected charities).

At the beginning of this season (summer 2018) our data from the first two years indicated that 56 percent of Mirasol residents have been involved in the Mirasol Foundation: through donating, fundraising, community service, and/or committee involvement. As the season progressed into this fall, it was evident that the percent of involvement has increased to well over 60 percent! We are receiving great financial and community support. During the first two years, we granted \$251,000 to over 24 different charities. It is the Board’s goal to continue growing, continue educating, and through the recent involvement of the youth of Mirasol, to continue mentoring. We invite you to find a place in the garden.

Because you are a Mirasol resident, you are a part of the Mirasol Foundation! If it hasn’t yet been your time to donate or volunteer, it doesn’t matter. You are still a part of Mirasol, and therefore, of the Mirasol Foundation. We welcome your input and your time, and we hope that you will be on hand April 11 to join us as we celebrate this season’s blooms. Come and grow with us!

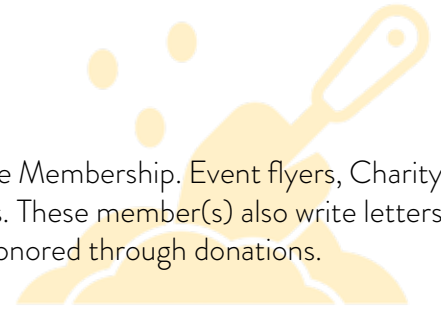

COMMUNITY SERVICE COMMITTEE “MIRASOULS”

This Committee provides varied non-financial support to Palm Beach County residents through community agencies and organizations (Charities) to help those who are indigent and/or in need of assistance to meet their basic life needs. They host annual food drives in November and April, a toy drive at the holidays, and a clothing and food drive in April. These drives benefit the Palm Beach County Food Bank, children identified by the Palm Beach Gardens Police and Fire Departments, Riviera Beach Outreach, and other charities as selected.

The Committee was originally a club started by Kathy Savarese and Roz Skigen in 2013 and became a committee of the Foundation in May 2016. Over **400** residents have donated their time and/or resources to this committee's work.

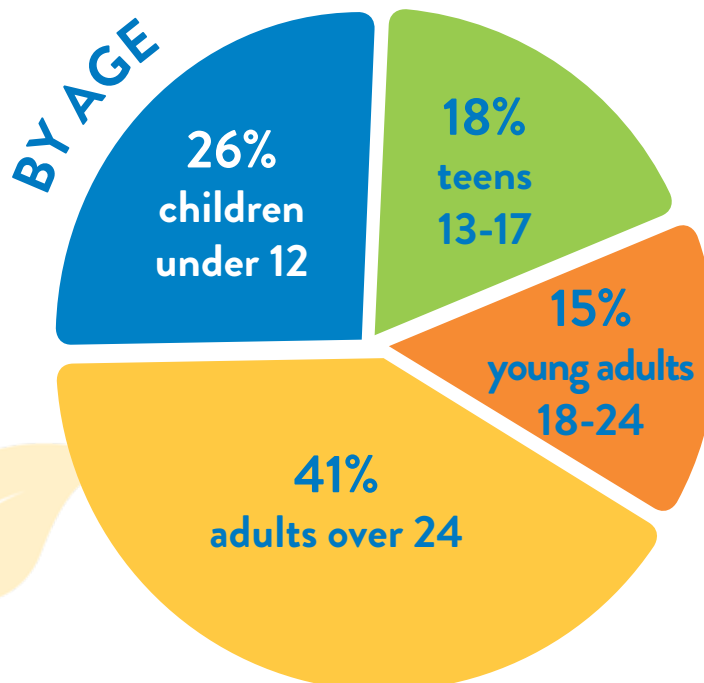
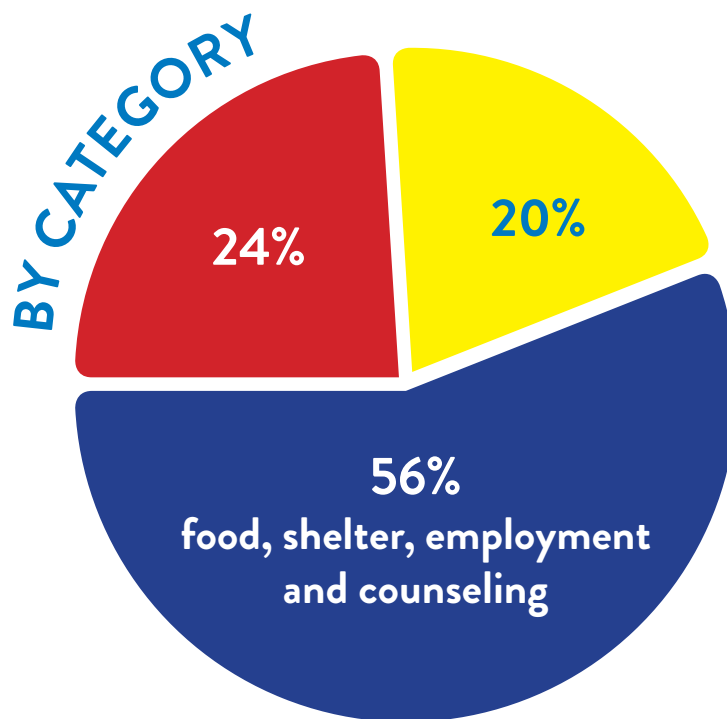
WHERE DOES OUR GRANT MONEY GO?

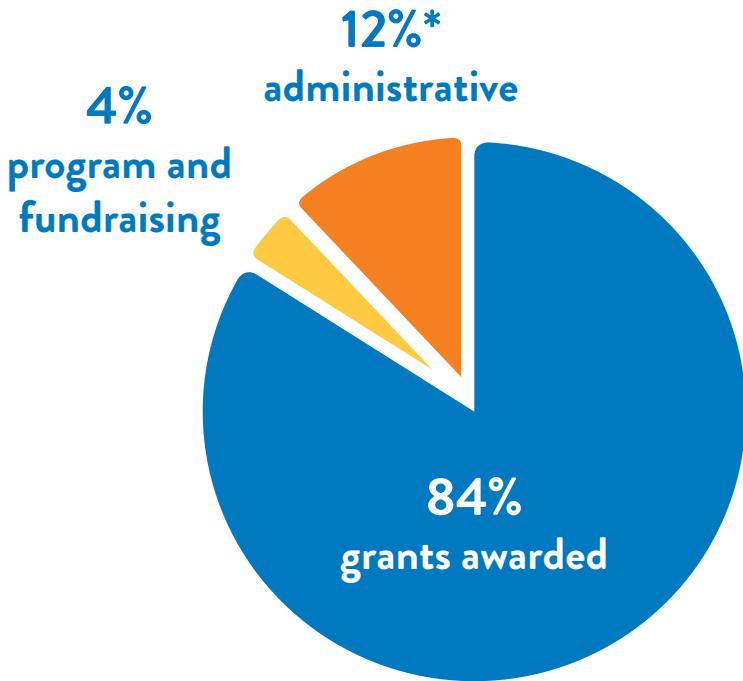

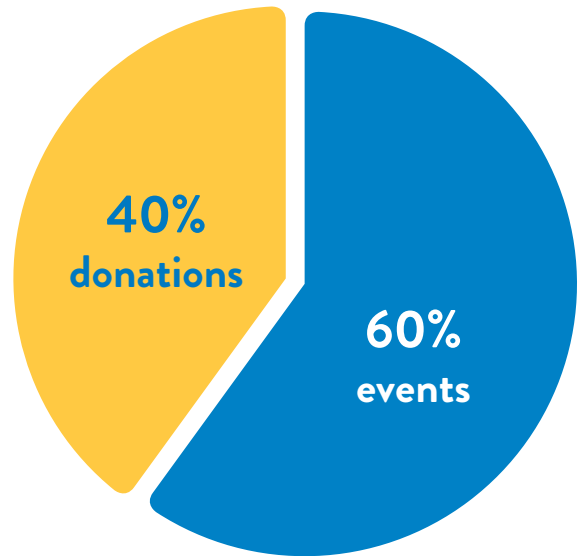

Two-Year Expenses \$300,000

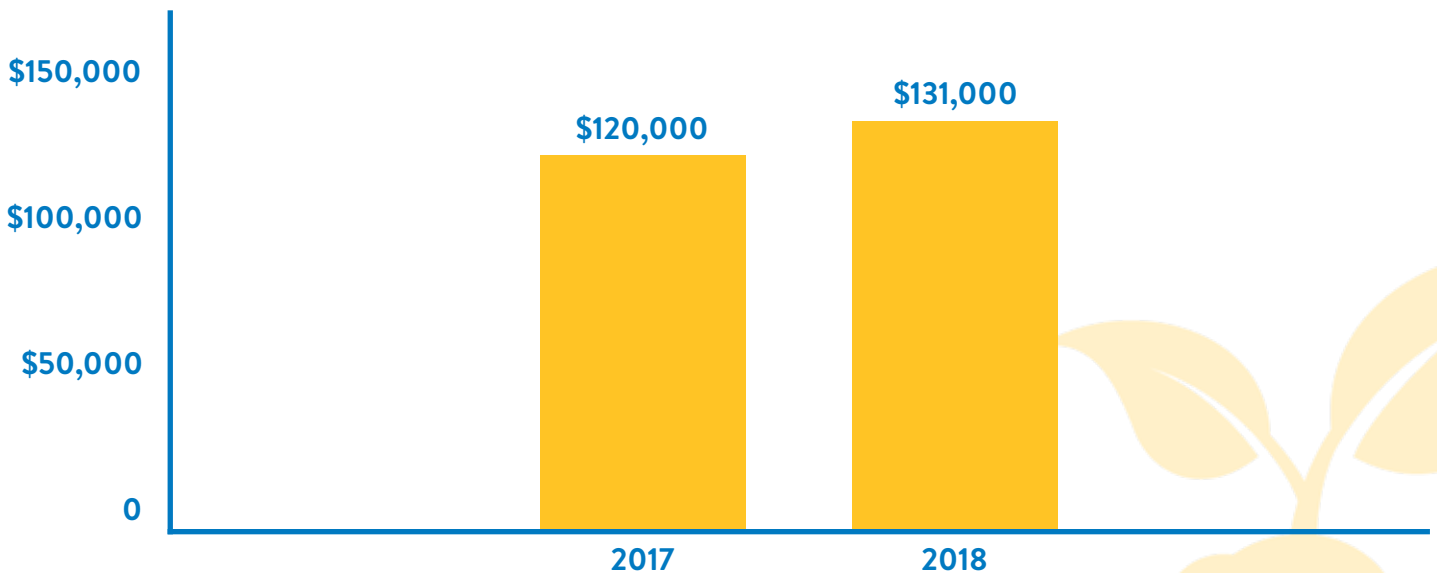


Two-Year Revenues \$335,000
